EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Melangking Palm Oil Mill (MPOM) a subsidiary company of AbadiMewah Group started operation in 15 February 2005. It is located at KM52, off Sandakan-LahadDatu highway. Processing capacity is 60mt Fresh Fruit Bunch (FFB)/hr. Major supplier of FFB is from Melangking Oil Palm Plantation (MOPP) accommodates 60% and 40% is from nearby small holders. The final products are Crude Palm Oil (PO) and Palm Kernel (PK). Both products are sold to all refinery in Sandakan and LahadDatu area for further refining and crushing process.

Stage 2 Audit was satisfactorily conducted to evaluate MSPO implementation at Melangking Palm Oil Mill. Stage 2 of MSPO certification was satisfactorily conducted by NIOSH Certification on 23rd November 2018. NIOSH Certification is a certification body accredited by Standards Malaysia which providing a comprehensive certification services system mainly for management system of occupational safety and health, environment, quality and MSPO for various industries.

The Stage 2 compliance audit was satisfactorily conducted to evaluate the MSPO implementation of Melangking Palm Oil Mill. During the audit closing meeting held on the overall results of the audit are as follows:

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AUDIT METHODOLOGY & AUDIT PROGRAMME

The assessment was conducted involving Melangking Palm Oil Mill (MPOM). The minimum manday has been justified as per ABC-OPMC 2 (Audit Duration for CB Operating Oil Palm Management Certification under MSPO scheme). The audit covers documentation review, internal policies and procedures, management system as well as records review in compliance with the audit criteria requirements, an interview sessions with relevant staff and workers such as foreman, workers, a stakeholders consultation and a site visit for observing mill operating activities such as loading, sterilizing, boilers operation, eater treatment plant, effluent pond, workshop, chemicals and scheduled waste store and etc.

SUMMARY AUDIT FINDINGS

During the audit closing meeting held on 23rd November 2018, the overall results of the audit are as follows:

The following items represented **positive observations** by the audit team:

- Good commitment and support from the management and staff of the MOPP Palm Oil Mill during the audit.
- b. Clean and good housekeeping as observed in MOPP Palm Oil Mill operation area.

The overall results of the audit are as follows:

- a. **NONE Major Nonconformity Report (NCR)**;
- b. THREE (3) Minor Nonconformity Report (NCR); and
- c. **THREE (3) –** Opportunity For Improvement (OFI)

*The grading of nonconformity (Major / Minor) is based on ISO/IEC 17021:2015 guidelines.

The audit team has satisfactorily verified the corrective action plan provided by the client. The effectiveness on the action plan for the corrective action will be reviewed by NIOSH Certification's auditors during the next surveillance audit.

Review and follow-up on previous audit findings

Three (3) Areas of Concern raised during the previous audit found has been addressed adequately. While balance another Three (3) Areas of Concern still recurring and upgraded into nonconformities during Stage 2 audit. The management of MPOM has taken action to improve understanding and implementation of MSPO prior to Stage 2 audit as informed and observed.

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Stakeholders Consultation Session

Stakeholder consultation began with notification of upcoming assessment by official letter 21st October 2018 to identified stakeholders. Emails, phone call and official letter were sent to applicable interested stakeholders. Audit team then visited some stakeholders to obtain positive / negative information or any issues in connection with Melangking Oil Palm Plantation. It was started with a slide presentation by NIOSH Certification Sdn. Bhd. explaining about the objectives of the MSPO certification scheme and purpose of stakeholder consultation. Agenda of discussion including legal compliance, environmental protection, biodiversity conservation, safety & social responsibility and development of community. No major adverse issue been raised as consulted during the audit:Among stakeholders attended the session:

Individual stakeholders were interviewed and consulted to get their views and opinions related to operation of Melangking Palm Oil Mill.

For contractors among issues discussed related to contract of work, job specification and payment of claim for job performed. As feedback received found no negative issues and MPOM has been providing a clear information on job specification and payment was made promptly. Training related to MSPO was given to their representatives that attended the session when invitation was made earlier. Neighbouring estates found not having any land disputes issues with MPOM. FFB were offered with a price as MPOB recommendation for smallholders and estates. Payment was made accordingly and slip of weight bridge tickets provided accordingly.

While for criminal cases and illegal workers, so far no reported cases involving MPOM. The management of MPOM has been working closely with police to maintain peace and harmony in the area.


All positive and negative inputs from stakeholders has been discussed with management of MOPP with proper justification and adequate action plan by the management team to address the issue.
